Highlights this year:

- Club membership continues to increase, with 99 members as of the close of this season.
- We officially moved our meeting location to the Brighton Reformed Church thanks to Dave Robinson.
- Back issues of Hinges & Tongs continue to be scanned by Larry Rausch and added to our club's web site.
- Philatelic displays were assembled by Fred Haynes at the Brighton and Pittsford Libraries in May.
- The RPA celebrated its centennial with a banquet at Locust Hill Country Club on Tuesday, March 12 with 48 members and 32 guests in attendance. It was the exact anniversary date of the club's founding.
- ROPEX/NTSS 2013 took place May 17-19, a joint production of the RPA and American Topical Association. It was held at a new venue, the Main Street Armory, as the Sports Centre in Henrietta was under renovation. A total of 46 dealers attended, with the RPA and ATA each having 130 frames of competitive exhibits. The club's profit from the show was roughly \$6,000, \$2,800 of which was spent beforehand to purchase new Plexiglas, metal stands and clips to prepare all of our 250 exhibit frames for it.
