- *Then I moved to German Stamps because they were easily accessible.
- *Then moved to collecting Scandinavian Countries.
- *When I lived in Switzerland, I collected Stamps from there.
- *When I came to the US, of course I wanted to get those Stamps.

*If I find a Stamp of interest, on a postcard, I will remove it and add it to my collection.


*When I travel, I will visit the local Post Offices.


