46th Stamp in the Transportation Coil Series.

Issued on 19 July 1988 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

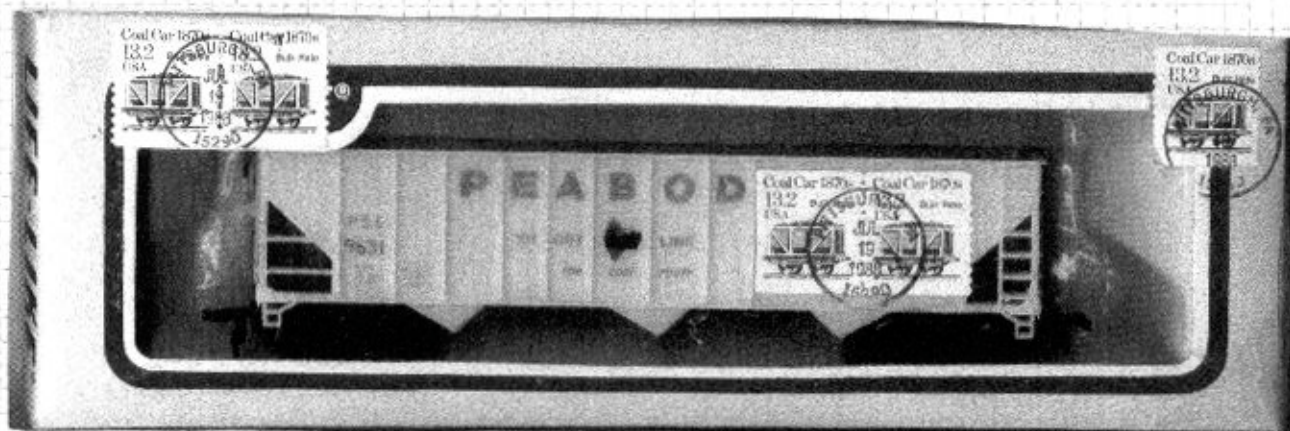
First day ceremony held on campus of Duquesne University at the Mellon Science Ctr.

Designed by Richard Schlecht.

Printed in rolls of 500; 3,000 and 10,000.

Provided for single piece rate of third class mailings presorted to 5-digit zip codes.

123,965 First day covers reported as cancelled.



Scan of Rick Kase creation. Seven HO-gauge coal cars were produced in this manner. One is owned by exhibitor; one by creator; one destroyed in a fire; whereabouts of other four unknown.

This collection contains different cachets and stamp combinations on cachets. Unofficial first day cancels are also included - some on plain covers. The cachet makers are in alphabetical order and this begins after the U.S.P.S. souvenir page.

**NOTE:** Small cancel = machine cancel applied at Philatelic Agency.  
Large cancel = rubber hand stamp available at first day site.
