

The Marcophily of Hudson, New York, 1793 - 1919

ORGANIZATION OF EXHIBIT: This exhibit is loosely arranged chronologically with some overlapping for most markings; grouping is based on the date stamp used (straight line, fancy, circular), variables including type of obliterator, die font, color, and auxiliary markings appearing.

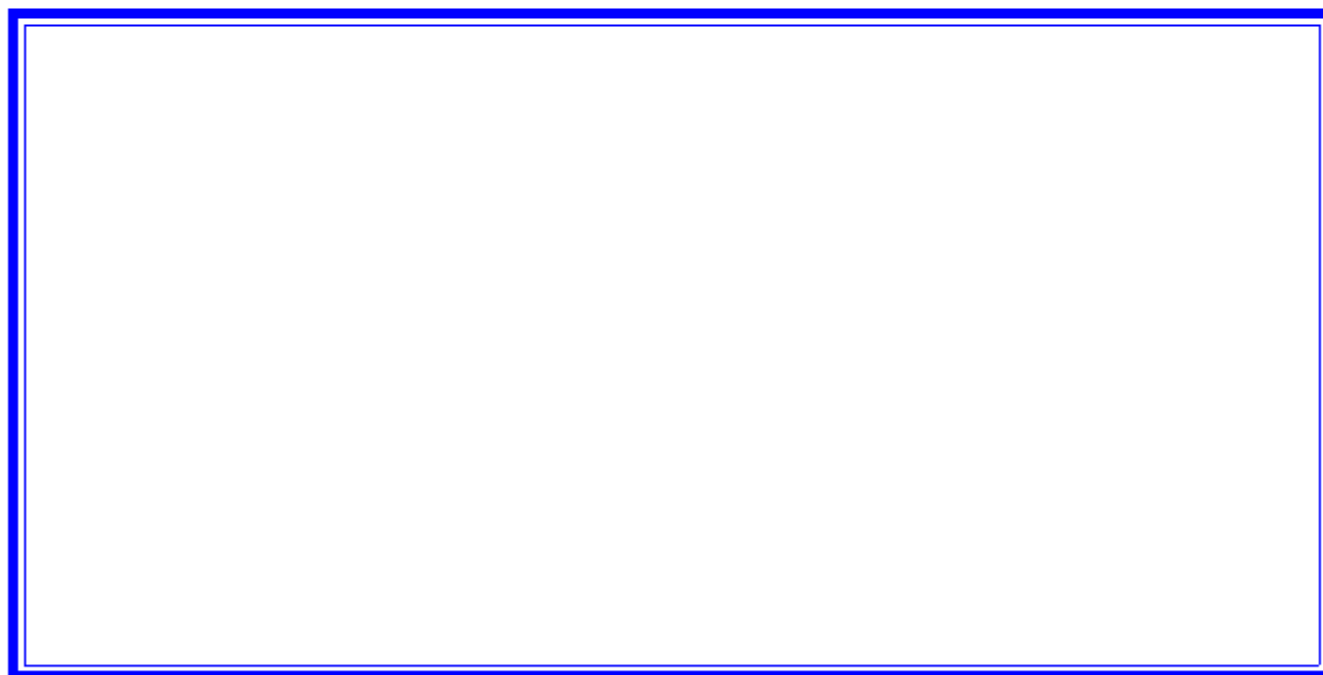
