**FRAME ONE – THE STAMP (includes 12 pages from 1930 collection):** 

Portrait of John Sullivan – Map of Campaign – Post Office Department announcement – P.O.D. letter February 21, 1930 – Model for stamp vignette – Block of 72 Sullivan commemoratives – Production variety and two production errors -- Bureau of Engraving and Printing (B.E.P.) letter October 24, 1929 – P.O.D. letter November 11, 1929 – B.E.P. letter March 7, 1930 – Matching plate blocks for each plate number – Full selvedge top plate blocks with "F".

### FRAME TWO – FIRST DAY COVERS:

Earlier P.O.D. announcement – Map showing first day sites – First day covers from official sites showing contemporary cachets and variety of official cancellations.

### FRAME THREE – FIRST DAY COVERS:

Unofficial first day covers from Lowman, NY, where the Battle of Newtown, the major engagement of the Campaign, took place – More first day covers from official sites with contemporary cachets and variety of official cancels – Unofficial Syracuse NY machine cancel and Binghamton Terminal RPO hand cancel.

### FRAME FOUR – FIRST DAY COVERS:

Add-on (non-contemporary) cachets from official sites – Corner cards and curiosities, including first day covers autographed by Alfred E. Smith and Franklin Delano Roosevelt – Machine and hand cancels from official sites not previously shown.

### FRAME FIVE – FIRST DAY COVERS:

More official cancel varieties not previously shown – Unofficial first day cancels, mostly upstate NY communities but including RPO and USS Pennsylvania cancels.
