

## Postal History Society

To encourage excellence in postal history collecting and exhibiting, the Postal History Society, Inc. provides medals or certificates to philatelic exhibitions meeting the following requirements.

#### Medals:

- 1. The exhibition must be one whose Grand Award winner is eligible to participate in the APS World Series of Philately.
- 2. The exhibition must have at least six (6) multi-frame postal history exhibits; single frame exhibits are not eligible for this award.
- 3. At least one of the judges should list postal history as a specialty.
- 4. The jury is strongly encouraged (but not obligated) to award the Postal History Society Medal to the best postal history exhibit, even if this duplicates another award.
- 5. The winning exhibit must receive at least a show vermeil.
- 6. The winner does  $\underline{not}$  have to be a member of the Postal History Society.
- 7. For the exhibition at which the Postal History Society holds its Annual Meeting, four awards will be presented: medals engraved "1st", "2nd", "3rd", as well as a Postal History Grand Award.

#### Certificates:

1. Any exhibition outside the APS World Series of Philately circuit may award a certificate if there are at least two postal history exhibits in competition and the winning exhibit received at least a show silver.

All exhibitions presenting a Postal History Society award are required to complete an Exhibition Award Report and mail it along with a show Palmares to the Postal History Society's awards chairperson.
