**Name of Award**                      **Astrophilatelic Award of the Space Unit (SU)**

**Criteria for Award**                      **Any philatelic exhibit—single or multiframe—that deals with aspects of the development of man’s capability in the exploration of space, beginning with stratospheric balloon and rocketry, to un-manned and manned exploration—is eligible to receive the SU Astrophilatelic Award.**

**Award Description and Application**                      **Gold, Silver and Bronze medals, awarded on the basis the exhibit receives in the open competition are correlated as follows:**

<b>Bronze, Certificate</b>	<b>Bronze</b>
